

## **The Buck Redding Swine Showcase**

### **General Rules**

1. The show is open to anyone up to the age of 21 (as of 9/1/19), from any state. Out of state youth are permitted to show, however, only FJSC members will accumulate points for the series.
2. Showmanship will start at 10:30am
3. Approximately 100 pens will be available on a first come, first served basis. You are allowed to show off of your trailer
4. The pens provided are on dirt. Shavings will be allowed as bedding. No straw or hay will be allowed.
5. Exhibitors must clean their pens before leaving the show.
6. All swine must have health papers at the time of unloading. All out of state swine must also have a Florida permit number on the health paper. All health papers must be issued with 90 days of December 20<sup>th</sup>.
7. It is recommended that all swine be vaccinated against Leptospirosis including Bratislava and erysipelas.
8. There is no limit on the number of animals you can show.
9. Power is limited. Generators are allowed outside of the barn.
10. All pigs must have a readable ear tag or an ear notch
11. Substitutions will be accepted the day of the show.
12. Showmanship is open to anyone. You may use someone else's hog, with their permission.
13. All exhibitors must be neatly dressed.
14. Official dress is not required.
15. Hog classes will be split by weight, except purebred breeding gilts, they will be shown by age.
16. Barrows and gilts only, no boars will be allowed.
17. The judge's decision is final.
18. Show officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
19. All animals must be removed 2 hours following the conclusion of the show.
20. The exhibitor and a parent/legal guardian must sign all entry forms.
21. The show committee, the Hardee Sr. FFA, nor the Hardee County Cattlemen's Arena will be responsible for any accidents or injuries at the show.
22. The show committee, the Hardee Sr. FFA, nor the Hardee County Cattlemen's Arena will be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items or damages to property.

### **Prospect Show Rules (Saturday after Showmanship)**

- All animals must be checked in from 6:00-9:00 am on Saturday December 21<sup>th</sup>, 2019
  - Hogs can be brought on Friday night, but will not be checked in or weighed until Saturday morning
- The purebred and crossbred shows will follow showmanship
- There will be two separate shows.
  - Purebreds (barrows and gilts)
  - Crossbred (barrows and gilts)
- All animals will be shown by weight, with a max of 300lbs
- Entry Fees are as follows:
  - a. \$25 per entry postmarked by 12/13/19
  - b. Late fee of \$10 per animal
  - c. Entries will be accepted at the show, exact cash only
  - d. Showmanship fee is \$10 per exhibitor
  - e. All entries are non-refundable

### **Breeding Gilt Show Rules (Friday Night)**

- Purebreds Gilts will be shown by age, must be born June 1 or after
- Crossbred Gilts shown by weight with a max of 300lbs
- Entry Fees are as follows:
  - f. \$25 per entry postmarked by 12/13/19
  - g. Late fee of \$10 per animal
  - h. Entries will be accepted at the show, exact cash only
  - i. Showmanship fee is \$10 per exhibitor
  - j. All entries are non-refundable
- Check-in for the gilt show will be Friday from 3-5:30. Entries must be turned in and hogs must be weighed by 5:30pm. The show will start at 6:30pm
- If you are showing the same hog on Saturday, it must be reweighed on Saturday morning.
